### **Strathmore Law Review Board Call for Submissions (2017/18)**

The Strathmore Law Review invites submissions for its upcoming third volume. The Strathmore Law Review is a student run, peer-reviewed academic journal. Submissions on any aspect of the Law in relation to Philosophy, Public Policy, Governance and Economics are welcomed from students currently enrolled in an undergraduate Bachelor of Laws program or a postgraduate diploma in a law program. The theme of the issue will be “Law towards a better society.” The preferred context of the submissions is the African continent.

The following works may be submitted:

1. **Articles:** A comprehensive and thorough analysis of issues related to the theme of the review. The word limit for articles is between 7,000 to 10,000 words.
2. **Case Comments:** Any academic writing that analyses or is a critique of a recent case. The word limit for commentaries is between 4,000 to 5,000 words.
3. **Any other submissions:** The Law review also invites other original works related to the law and legal industry. For example, normative law articles, essays on the legal profession, legal education or a brief

analysis of a recent policy or development in the law.

### **Submission Guidelines**


1. All submissions must adhere to the Strathmore Law Review Editorial Policy and Style Guidelines (available at [www.press.strathmore.edu](http://www.press.strathmore.edu)).
2. All submissions must be in Times New Roman, font size 12, line spacing 1.5, justified alignment.
3. All footnotes should be in Times New Roman, font size 10, Line Spacing 1.0 and should conform to the SLASLEC Style.
4. All word limits are inclusive of footnotes.
5. All submissions must be accompanied with an abstract of no more than 200 words detailing the general arguments and ideas contained in the paper.
6. Attached to the manuscript should be a copy of the Author's Information and Declaration of Originality form appropriately filled (both are attached here).
7. All entries should be submitted in .doc or .docx
8. The manuscripts must be e-mailed to [lawreview@Strathmore.edu](mailto:lawreview@Strathmore.edu)
9. Submission Deadline: The last date for submissions is **Tuesday 15 August 2017**. Any submissions after midnight of this date shall not be accepted.

## **Other Instructions to Note**

1. The Strathmore Law Review requires exclusive submission meaning the work submitted should not have been submitted for publishing or published in any other forum.
2. The author(s) bear sole responsibility for the accuracy of facts, opinions or views stated in the submitted manuscript. In case of any gross plagiarism found in the contents of submitted manuscript, the manuscript shall be subject to rejection.
